Just the Basics

- 9x12 or 11x14 Mixed Media Sketchbook, lay flat, perforated, at least 138lb/224g paper (Canson, Strathmore 400 Series White or Black Paper)
- Basic water-color set OR Basic Tombow Marker Set Grays OR Primaries
- Non-water soluble detail drawing tool (<u>pencil</u>, <u>pen</u>, <u>charcoal pencil</u>, <u>colored pencils</u>, <u>fine line pen</u>, <u>white gel pen</u>)
- Water soluble detail drawing tool (<u>Woody</u>, <u>Stabilo All Pencil</u>, <u>water color pencils</u>, <u>Lyra water soluble graphite</u>)
- Pentel Fude Brush Pen
- Water Brush
- Squeegee, Catalyst Wedge or Old Credit Card
- Large Tube or Jar of White Acrylic Paint OR Gouache
- Glue Stick

- Acrylic Paint Markers (Posca, Colnk)
- Oil Pastel (Water Soluble or Non-Water Soluble)
- Liquid Charcoal
- Ink Tense Colored Pencils

- Powdered Charcoal or Graphite
- Colored Gel Pens
- Incense or Pyrography tool
- Spray bottle or mister
- Scissors or exacto knife
- Stencils (Decorative, architectural or mesh of any kind)
- Masking or Painters Tape
- Ink (Alcohol, acrylic, water color, India, Sumi)
- Found objects (sticks, plastic lids, any household object)
- Faber Castell Pitt Pen Set
- Chalk pastels or pastel pencils
- Silicone tipped mark-making tool set
- Art-graf water soluble graphite tailors chalk or Drawing Putty
- Caran d'ache neocolor II Crayons
